

Indivisible Sacramento Facebook Posting Guidelines

Indivisible Sacramento's Facebook Group is designed to serve two purposes. First, it is a source for information about our group activities and priorities. Second, it is a forum for group members to engage in discussion. While we want this to be a site where everyone can contribute, we cannot approve every single post. In order to make our group site as effective and fair as possible, we have designed the following guidelines for posts.

- First, and most obviously, no abusive, violent, rude or derogatory remarks will be allowed.
- We also will absolutely not allow any political campaign fights. Indivisible Sacramento welcomes all who wish to oppose the Trump Administration and wish to work to restore our democratic norms and institutions.
- When there is a high priority event or goal (such as a Supreme Court nomination), we may occasionally delay accepting posts that are not related to the primary message.
- No lengthy posts or rants, please.
- Occasionally, outside groups or political candidates will post information or events on the site. We will generally allow these posts for informational purposes (as long as they are related to our mission), but these should not be taken as endorsements of any candidate or outside group.
- For the most part, we want to avoid posting memes, Twitter screenshots, etc.
- When sharing news stories, please make sure they are related to Indivisible's goal or to our group's activities. Also, news stories should be from reputable, mainstream news sources - we want to avoid conspiracy theories or incorrect information.
- Statements or declarations of fact should be sourced with a link.
- We want to make sure many voices are heard and make sure nobody dominates the conversation, so if one-person posts too many times in a given day or week, we may not allow all of the posts to go through.
- Finally, we ask you to please be patient if your post takes a while to be approved. Our page administrators are volunteers, and sometimes it may take some time before we are able to read through all of the pending posts.
